The universities that collaborate under the National Science Foundation (NSF) funded PRAISys project (Lehigh, Florida Atlantic and Georgia State universities) will be conducting the "Interdependent Infrastructure Incident" (I3) exercise from 8:30am to 11:45am on May 17th, 2018, Cypress Room A&B at the Governor's Hurricane Conference® in West Palm Beach, Florida.

The "Interdependent Infrastructure Incident" I3 exercise will feature a tabletop (discussion-based) exercise within the framework of a simulated disaster scenario. Experts in:

- Power Utilities
- Water Utilities
- Transportation Infrastructure
- Communication Infrastructure
- Healthcare Systems
- Emergency Management

... and other government from the Florida peninsula are encouraged to participate. Participants will be asked to share the information and criteria used to make decisions related to infrastructure restoration and prioritization. In addition to engaging individual experts, roundtable discussions will allow participants to interact with their colleagues from other agencies and disciplines.
