



2019 Student Presentations

As part of the 2019 conference program, the Governor's Hurricane Conference® (GHC) is hosting a workshop for students to present original academic research on *Friday, May 17 from 10:30 a.m. – Noon*. Students currently enrolled in institutions of higher education and who have taken or are taking emergency management related courses are encouraged to submit an abstract for the 33rd Annual GHC in May. Presenting at the conference is a unique opportunity for students to share their emergency management knowledge and expertise with their student peers, conference participants and emergency management professionals as well as gain valuable feedback from practitioners.

Presentation Guidelines

Presentations must focus on the student's original research, and the topic must be related to the field of emergency management. Students should prepare a short PowerPoint presentation that includes the research methodology and data sources used for the project. Students will have 10-15 minutes to present their findings and following the presentation, there will be opportunity to discuss their topic with a panel of emergency management stakeholders. In addition, students will be asked to submit a poster on their research, to be displayed throughout the week. Additional poster requirements will be sent upon selection.

Application Requirements

- Students must complete the application form and attach a one-page abstract that includes their research question, methodology, and data sources. If the research is in progress, you must list the date you anticipate research will be complete.
- Limited financial assistance to offset travel costs may be available based on demonstrated need.
- Accepted presenters must send their presentation and a PDF version of the poster to the moderator electronically at least 7 days before the conference or the presentation will be disqualified.

Deadline

Application and abstract must be submitted by March 15, 2019 via email to Jessica Geib at Jessica.Geib@uss.salvationarmy.org with a subject line of "**2019 GHC Student Presentation Proposal.**" The selected presentations will be announced mid-April.
