Opinion: Can't be 'too prepared,' PSL emergency manager says after tornado destroys home

Billy Weinshank, director of Port St. Lucie's emergency operations division, has spent a 30-year career planning for disasters to strike.

It's his business to prepare for different scenarios that could disrupt the city's operations, the lives of local residents, or both. Yet even with his decades of training and experience, Hurricane Milton served up a surprise that affected him on a deeply personal level.

On Oct. 9, while preparing for a 5 p.m. pre-storm meeting with the city's management staff, he got a panicked call from his usually calm wife, Suzanne.

"She called me and I couldn't understand what she was saying," Weinshank said. "She was screaming and crying."

Rebuilding homes and highways and hospitals is one thing. Rebuilding hearts, minds, memories, and community is another.






Crisis Stabilization provides structured effective means to repair a community, reducing social costs & accelerating healing.

Afterwards: Theraputic Support - renegotiation skills





Crisis Stabilization, Safety, Support


